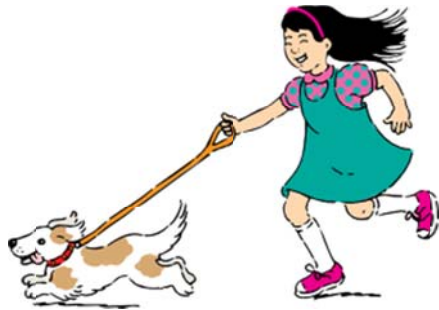

Every day, animals in our community live with neglect, abuse and terrible treatment by uncaring owners; animals kept chained, confined to cages, underfed, left out to contend with the elements without protection; animals deprived of medical care or love; animals ignored, or worse, intentionally harmed or abandoned to fend for themselves.

For 70 years the PHS has rescued and cared for the abused, neglected and abandoned animals that have come into its care.

Each year, close to 2,000 animals enter our facility in need of love, attention, medical help and forever homes. Many leave our care to go to homes where they will find love for the very first time in their lives.

The funds to provide Animal Protective Services to protect and care for these amazing animals, and to provide educational programs to prevent cruelty to animals, come from donations and fundraising events.

The Friends for Life Walk for the Animals is our major annual fundraiser. Funds raised will provide medical care, vaccines, spay/neuter surgeries and educational programs.

The animals need your help and you can give them that help by joining us for this fun event.
