



Peterborough's Dog Bylaws

Peterborough's bylaws are in place to encourage a community where pets, their owners and neighbours can all live in safety and harmony.



Dogs cannot be "at large." Dogs that are out without their owners or not under control are "at large".

\$125.00 Penalty



Dogs must be on leash at all times unless within a securely fenced yard or in a designated off-leash area. Visible signs are posted for off-leash areas.

\$125.00 Penalty



All dogs must be licensed and wear tags at all times.

\$125.00 Penalty



When dogs are taken off their property, their owners must "stoop and scoop". All owners are responsible to clean up after their dogs.

\$125.00 Penalty



Dogs must not be a nuisance by barking.

\$125.00 Penalty



Dogs must not chase, threaten or attack people or other animals.

Dog Owners' Liability Act – penalty set by court



Dogs are not permitted in Del Cray Park (May-October) or the soccer field at King Edward Park

\$125.00 Penalty
